[Data processing]

The Controller processes your data for the following purpose: to communicate on investor relations – the legal basis for the processing is the necessity to process data to pursue the controller's legitimate interests; the controller's legitimate interests consist in sending information to investors related to corporate events and upholding the market standards espoused by the Company as a publicly-traded entity. The provision of data for the foregoing purpose is voluntary, though necessary to achieve that purpose.

[Data storing period]

Your personal data will be stored until the moment when you submit your request to cease receiving the newsletter.

[Data transfers]

Your personal data may be transferred to data processors that process personal data under engagement from the controller, which may include among others: IT service providers; however, such data processors process data based on an agreement with the controller and solely in accordance with the controller's instructions.

[Your rights]

You have the right to access your personal data and to demand corrections to such data, to remove them or restrict their processing.

In order to exercise the foregoing right, you should contact the controller or the Data Protection Inspector using the contact data specified above.

You have the right to submit a complaint to the regulatory authority responsible for personal data protection in Poland.
